

## “We Believe in keeping you Safe”

Safety of the child is utmost priority of every school. To ensure the same school organized an Awareness camp about Road Safety. Parents of our little brigade of Pre-Primary wing were invited for a workshop on Road Safety. Principal Mrs. Mala Sood address the parents for being safe on roads.

Students of Pre-Primary wing welcome parents by reciting poem on traffic rules and road safety. The spokesperson **Mr. Mahesh ASI from Traffic Police Department** Roshnara Road enlightened parents about various Road Safety Rules that they often tend to ignore.

The parents were appraised of this fact :

- traffic hurts millions of people every year across the world, and someone dies every 30 seconds globally in road crashes.
- People hurt by traffic are often killed and seriously injured. Injuries include paralysis and losing limbs. (Note: many children may think minor injuries such as breaking an arm are okay – you may need to make clear how awful a serious injury is.)
- Some people do dangerous things when walking or cycling, such as texting on their phone while crossing a road, or not wearing a helmet. These people are more likely to be killed or hurt.
- Some drivers do dangerous things, which increase the chance of them killing or hurting themselves or someone else, for example, speeding, or using a phone at the wheel, or driving after drinking alcohol. We have laws such as speed limits to stop people being killed or hurt in crashes, but some drivers break them.
- Importance of wearing helmets by driver and the second person sitting on two wheeler. Quality of helmet should be ISI mark.
- New fine system, People are afraid of fine but they should concentrate on their lives more than to be penalized.
