The timings for the Dispersal of children of ON FOOT is 12.50 p.m. It is suggested that avail school bus facility to avoid any kind of inconvenience. In mid of the session the transport facility will not be provided/withdrawal. Parents those are availing for the Private Van school is not liable for any security during transportation.

➤ On foot Parents are requested to drop their children at school's Gate No. 1 only and park your vehicles atleast 50 meters away from the school gate.(beyond the barricade)

All Saturdays will be a holiday for the children.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

DAVCMC has decided to introduce a common uniform in all DAV Schools therefore from the academic session 2017-18; the school would be following the common uniform pattern as per the guidelines of DAV Managing Committee **Uniform not meeting the set criteria will not be allowed.**

Summer Uniform will be resumed from 5thApril 2017. You are requested to check that your ward is dressed decently in proper school uniform with Identity Card compulsory worn even on PTMs. Every child should wear the prescribed school uniform. It should be well washed and ironed. The uniform should be accurate in size. Girls should not apply Mehandi, Nail Paints.
